National Ukrainian Museum: Times, People, Fates

The scientific conference will be held at the National Art Museum of Ukraine (Hrushevskoho st, 6, Kyiv) on **October 8–9, 2024**.

On August 5 (17), 1899, the first exhibition dedicated to the XI Archaeological Congress opened in five halls of the Kyiv City Museum of Antiquities and Arts. From that moment on, the history of Ukraine's three leading museums, the National Art Museum of Ukraine, the National Museum of the History of Ukraine, and the National Museum of Decorative Arts of Ukraine, began.

The conference is devoted to the history of the City Museum of Antiquities and Arts and previously unknown pages of the museum's construction, the formation of collections, the Old Kyiv department, the history of the library, Mykola Biliashivskiy's project *National Ukrainian Museum*, the staff who lived and worked at the museum, and much more.

The conference should cover a wide range of issues related to the history of the Kyiv City Museum of Antiquities and Arts and the museums that emerged on its basis, as well as the development of museums in Ukraine.

The scientific conference will be organized into the sections:

1. Pages from the history of the Kyiv City Museum and its successor museums.
2. Founders and employees, their contribution to the development of museums.
3. Formation, preservation and popularization of collections.
4. Museums and War (World War I and II, Russian-Ukrainian war (since 2014)).
5. Museums yesterday, today, and tomorrow. Topical issues concerning museum studies.

Languages: Ukrainian, English.

The conference will be held in a mixed format: offline and online. Conference IDs will be announced separately.

Applications for participation in the scientific conference and texts of reports should be sent to the following e-mail address: namumuseum.academy@gmail.com, before **September 15, 2024**. Based on the results of the work, it is planned to prepare a collection of conference materials (articles, theses) to be posted on the official websites of NAMU, NMHU, NMDAU.

Requirements for text formatting.

The file name is formed according to the principle of *Article_Full Name*. The article should contain metadata that is published and stored in information and scientometric databases: ORCID of the author(s); information about the author(s) in Ukrainian and English (academic degree, academic title, position, name and address of the institution where the author(s) work); e-mail address of the author(s); title of the publication in Ukrainian and English; keywords (5–8) and an abstract in Ukrainian and English.

The text volume is up to 30,000 characters in A4 computer-typed format at 1.5 interval (20 mm margins on all sides, font size 14 Times New Roman) MS Word (doc, docx); references to sources should be formatted in APA style. When referring to electronic sources, the date of access (in parentheses) to the electronic document should be indicated. Illustrations to the text (up to 10) should be submitted as separate files in JPG format with consecutive numbering in Arabic numerals and captions; links to the illustrations in the text should be indicated under their serial number; image size – at least 300 dpi; captions to the illustrations should be provided in a separate file. The author(s) is responsible for the content, grammatical and stylistic correctness of the article.

The Organizing Committee of the scientific conference will not consider papers that do not meet the above requirements.
